Welcome Back to Summer term in the Poppy Room

LOTS TO LEARN AND EXPLORE:

This term we are starting to learn about growing and things that grow. Some of the books we are sharing this term are all about growing and we are planning lots of activities around the stories in these books.

We are planting sunflower seeds and cress seeds and will be watching to see how they grow. We will also be looking at how we are growing, how tall we are and how we are similar and different to our peers.

We are practicing our counting, using different ways to measure, such as rulers, tape measures and height charts.


We have received delivery of some caterpillars at pre-school, and we will observe the process as they change into beautiful butterflies

We will be looking at the other changes in our outdoor environment, so take time to look around on your way to pre-school to see the many colours of the spring flowers and to look out for butterflies during the summer months.

We will be singing and acting out lots of songs including 'Little caterpillar on a Leaf' And Five Little Peas

For those children leaving us this summer to start school in September, we will begin to focus on developing our skills such as cutting and building up strength in our hands. We will be looking at recognising our own name and will be starting to form some of the letters in our name.

We will also be encouraging the older children to become more independent, placing their coats on their pegs, washing their hands and washing up their own plates and cups at snack time. We will be thinking about and discussing healthy eating and choosing and cutting our own food and pouring our own drink at snack time.
