
Welcome Back to Summer term in the Daisy Room

LEARNING THROUGH PLAY:


This term in Daisy Room we are sharing the book, *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, by Eric Carle, and will base lots of our learning through play activities around the story in the book.



The children will look at our *Very Hungry Caterpillar* story sack together and will use snack time as an opportunity to try the different foods mentioned in the story.



We will spend time together on a bug hunt in the outdoor garden and doing caterpillar and butterfly paintings and caterpillar posting and threading activities.



To help prepare some of our older children, who will be moving up to the Poppy and Sunflower Rooms in September, we will begin to sit together more often as a group for our story-time and the older children will also begin to learn some of the routines followed in the Poppy and Sunflower room.

The older children will be encouraged to become more independent, for example finding and opening their own lunch box and helping to wash up their plate and cup after snack time. They will practice standing as still as a tree whilst an adult gives instructions such as asking everyone to put the toys away or asking everyone to sit down as group at home-time for a story or singing.

Please can we ask you to send us a family photo (one which you would be happy for us to display in the Daisy Room) so the children can use the photo to help them talk about their family members. You can bring a photograph to pre-school or if you would prefer, upload a copy on tapestry for us to print.
